1. The present petition was filed by the petitioner for the reason that the Chairperson of DRAT, New Delhi was not holding the Court.

2. Mr. Akshay Chandra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that now learned Chairperson, DRAT, New Delhi has resumed his office, therefore, petitioner shall be prosecuting his appeal, which has already been filed before learned DRAT. He, however, urges that petitioner may be protected for a period of two weeks.
